5/29/13	\$ 4,000	St. Patrick’s Catholic Church, Elkhorn – Assist family of a Brother Knight with payment of large medical large medical bills for a daughter with serious health problems
5/18/11	\$ 600	Catholic Newman Center – Widows Mite Foundation Grant
5/12/11	\$ 1,100	St. Luke’s Catholic Church – Help Tyrel Gafford’s family of Ogallala in desperate need arising from untimely death of the father Tyrel leaving behind a wife and 4 children, ages 6, 4, 2 and 3 days old
7/30/08	\$ 1,000	Mid America Boy Scout Council – To support Boy Scouts who lost life in summer 2008 Iowa tornado
7/24/08	\$ 1,200	Holy Family Shrine – Grant for brochures for Holy Family Shrine along Interstate 80 between Omaha and Lincoln to increase awareness for financial support and use
5/29/08	\$ 135	St. Mary’s Catholic Church, Wayne
5/7/08	\$ 1,000	Christ the King Catholic Church, Cozad – Subsidize cost of a \$5,000 scan for Brother Knight Allen Donahey
4/27/07	\$10,000	The Madonna Foundation, Lincoln–Help handicapped and stroke victims
11/16/06	\$ 1,000	Valentine Fire Victims Aid – In August, 2006, a major wild fire Destroyed over 3,000 acres of rangeland in the Valentine area. Part of the fire was within a mile of the city of Valentine. Funds donated were part of a matching challenge by the local Knights of Columbus council to aid victims in the area.
8/1/06	\$ 2,000	Ride for Larry – Fundraiser for Brother Larry Schroetlin of Butte who was thrown from his bike crossing a railroad track while in Broken Bow for the start of the Bike Ride Across Nebraska annual event. Larry fractured the second vertebrae in his neck and lost all feeling from the neck down.
1/16/17	\$ 3,000	Defray medical expenses for Ogallala/Paxton St. Luke Council 4979 Grand Knight Paul Ruhlman who needs both of his hips replaced. During preparatory exams cancer was detected that first must be

eradicated. Paul is self employed, but his medical issues have left him unable to work.

1/16/17	\$ 3,000	Jon and Jamie Yoachim family joined the Catholic Church three years ago. Jon is a member of Hebron Liberty Council 1904. Donovan, who is one year old and the youngest of three children, started having seizures in 2016 and was life flighted to Omaha Children's Hospital. Tests showed kidney failure and possible brain damage. Donovan was moved to Madonna Rehabilitation Center in Omaha which cost \$12,000 to have him admitted. After returning home, he suffered a relapse and was readmitted to Children's Hospital.
6/10/17	\$ 5,000	Continued support for the Jon and Jamie Yochum Family. Their son Donavan who is one and a half years having some serious health issues which has caused brain damage. He has been in the hospital or some type of care unit since Nov. 2016. Right now they had to move to Denver, Colorado for further treatment. They are going to be there for a year. The medical treatment is very expensive. The treatment that he is receiving is second to none, and he is showing improvement.
